PARTIES TO DISPUTE: { Brotherhood of **Railway**, Airline and Steamship Clerks.
 { **Freight Handlers**, Express and **Station Employees**
 { **Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company**

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: **Claim** of the System Committee of the **Brotherhood (GL-9032)**
that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not
● pply the provisions of the **General Agreement** and **Memorandum Agreement** &ted
September 1, 1949 and arrange to allow P. K. O'Donnell, 4 days in excess of
252 Annual Work Days in 1975.

(b) The Carrier should now **recompute** P. K. O'Donnell pay for the
Year 1975 and allow him \$111.56 for 2 days pay due to working 4 days in excess
of the **252 Annual Work Days in 1975.**

OPINION OF BOARD: Except as to **name** of **Claimant**, the Claimant's rate of pay,
and • **claim** for two days' **pay** instead of one day's psy, this
claim is identical to that considered by the Boerd in Award No. 23589. Upon
full review of the record, an identical award is appropriate, based upon all
the **same reasoning.**

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and
all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties **waived oral** hearing:

That the **Carrier** and the **Employees** involved in this dispute are
respectively **Carrier** and **Employees** within the meaning of the **Railway Labor Act**,
as ● pproved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment **Board** has jurisdiction over the
dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement **was violated.**
