## PARTIES TO **DISPUTE**:

(Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company

STATEMENTOF CIAIM: (:laim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9034) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the General Agreement and **Memorandum** Agreement dated September 1, **1949** and **arrange** to  $\bullet$  llcw W. H. Martin, 2 days in excess of **252** Annual Work Days in **1975**.

(b) The Carrier should now recompute W. H. Martin pay for the Year **1975** and allow him **\$123.10** for 2 days pay due to working 2 days in excess of the 252 Annual Work Days in **1975**.

<u>OPINION OF BOARD</u>: Except as to name of Claimant, the Claimant's rate of pay, and a claim for two days' pay instead of one day's pay, this claim is identical to that considered by the Board in Award No.23589. Upon full review of the record, an Identical award is appropriate, based upon all the same reasoning.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the **Adjustment** Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as apprwed **June** 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction **over** the dispute involved herein: and

That the Agreement was violated.
