STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9035) that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the General Agreement and Memorandum Agreement dated September 1, 1949 and rrmge to allow Marcus N. Pea-due, 2 days, in excess of 252Annual Work Days in 1975.
- (b) The Carrier should now recompute M. N. **Perdue's** pay for the **year** 19'75 **and** allow him **\$112.92** for 2 days **pay** due to working 2' days in excess of the 252 Annual Work Days in 1975.

DPINION OF BOARD: Except as to name of Claimant, the Claimant's rate of pay, and a claim for two days' pay instead of one day's pay.this claim is identical to that considered by the Board in Awud No. 23589. Upon full review of the record, an identical award is appropriate, pased upon all the same reasoning.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the **partie**: waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the **meaning** of the **Railway** Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
