<u>PARTIES TO DISPUTE:</u> (Brotherhood of Railway. Airline and Steamship Clerks, (Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes ((Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company

<u>STATEMENT OF CLAIM</u>: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9075) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the General Agreement and Memorandum Agreement dated September 1, 1949 and arrange to allow Douglas M. **Stoll** 2 days in excess of **251** Annual Work Days in 1976.

(b) The Carrier should now recompute Douglas M. **Stoll's** pay for the year 1976 and allow him \$137.36 for 2 days pay due to working 2 days in excess of the 251 Annual Work Days in 1976.

<u>OPINION OF BO</u>ARD: The issue in this claim is identical to that considered in Award 23589. The claim will be sustained on the basis of that Award.

<u>FINDINGS</u>: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record **and** all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.

AWARD

Claim sustained.
