PARTIES TO DISPUTE: ( (Brotherhood of Railway; Airline and Steamship **Clerks,**  
( Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes  
(Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood  
(GL-9128) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the General Agreement and Memorandum Agreement dated September 1, 1949 and arrange to allow Walter C. Jones 2 days in excess of 251 Annual Work Days in 1976.

(b) The Carrier should now recompute Walter C. Jones' pay for the year 1976 and allow him \$137.36 for 2 days pay due to working 2 days in excess of the 251 **Annual** Work Days in 1976.

OPINION OF BOARD: The issue in this claim is identical to that considered in Award 23589. The claim will be sustained on the basis of **that** Award.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That **the** parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
