PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company

STATEMENTOF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9234) that:

(a) The **Carrier violated** the **Clerical** Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the **General** Agreement and Memorandum **Agreement** dated September 1, 1949 and arrange to allow R. R. **Hummel** 2 days in excess of 251 Annual Work Days in 1976.

(b) The Carrier should now recompute R. H. Hummel's pay for the year 1976 and allow him \$1669.93 ♦ 22 x 2 for 2 days Pay due to working 2 days in excess of the 251 Annual Work Days in 1976.

<u>OPINION OF BOARD</u>: The issue in this claim is identical to that considered in Award 23589. The claim will be sustained on the basis of that Award.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board,, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved **June 21**, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.

AWARD

Claim sustained.
