STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Does the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company's use of Serrmi Corporation to assist in the installation of Centralized Traffic Control as part of its Rehabilitation Project violate the Scope Rule, or any other rule, in the Collective Bargaining Agreements applicable to St. Louis Southwestern and the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen?

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the **complainant** party; and


