PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(The Western Pacific Railroad Company

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The dismissal of Foreman S. R. Diaz was without just and sufficient cause, harsh and wholly disproportionate to the charges leveled against him (Carrier's File GM Case No. 11851-1979-EMWE, Local Case No. 278).
- (2) Foreman S. R. Diaz shall be reinstated with seniority and all other rights unimpaired and be compensated for all wage loss suffered."

OPINION OF BOARD: Claimant S. R. Diaz, a Foreman, MS served with a Notice of Investigation on April 5,1979 "to determine facts ad place your responsibility for your alleged pilfering for your private use, certain amounts of (the Carrier's) fuel and oil". Claimant was dismissed on April 15,1979.

Examination of the record before the Board establishes that Claimant had a fair and impartial hearing. Claimant admitted taking five gallons of gasoline from the Carrier, and a number of witnesses stated that they had seen him take Carrier's materials. There was substantial evidence in the record to sustain the Carrier's decision to discipline Claimant. Dismissal is an appropriate penalty fortheft.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this **Division** of **the Adjustment Board has** jurisdiction over the dispute **involved** herein; **and**

That the Agreement was not violated.

A W A R D

Claim denied.
