STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad

Signalmen on Consolidated Rail Corporation:

That Signal Maintainer **J. Brodeur** be restored to service of the Carrier with all rights and benefits unimpaired and be compensated for all lost wages from the date of his suspension and subsequent dismissal. [Carrier file No. **SD-2051-D**]

OPINION OF BOARD: This is a companion to Award 25426. The facts are identical and set forth in that Award, together with **our** decision.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved **June** 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was not violated.
