Giger et al, for payment of 43 hours each at their respective punitive rates of pay account of Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement, as amended, particularly the Scope Rule, when it allowed or permitted Carrier Officers to perform signal work." Carrier's File No. 890773. BRS Case No. 8215-UP.

FINDINGS:

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.
