

**NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD
THIRD DIVISION**

PARTIES TO DISPUTE: (Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees
(Union Pacific Railroad Company (former Missouri
(Pacific Railroad)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Agreement was violated when the Carrier posted Bulletin Nos. SST00257 (trackman/driver), SST00258 (trackman), SST00260 (trackman/driver) and SST00261 (trackman) as System Rail Gang positions instead of Division Rail Gang positions (Carrier's File 920316 MPR).
- (2) The Agreement was violated when the Carrier posted Bulletin Nos. SSF00128 (track foreman), SST00253 (trackman/driver) and SST00254 (trackman) as System Rail Gang positions instead of Division Rail Gang positions (Carrier's File 920323 MPR).
- (3) As a consequence of the violations referred to in Parts (1) and/or (2) above, the Carrier shall cancel the bulletins as advertised and re-bulletin them to the respective Division forces."

FINDINGS:

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute were given due notice of hearing thereon.

At issue in this dispute is the right of the Carrier to bulletin certain positions as System Gang positions rather than Division Gang positions. Many, if not all of the arguments advanced by the Organization in support of its claim were disposed of in denial Third Division Awards 29977, 30086 and 30087, involving these same parties.

The Board does not find the three denial Awards to be in palpable error. The claim involved here will be denied.

AWARD

Claim denied.

ORDER

This Board, after consideration of the dispute identified above, hereby orders that an award favorable to the Claimant(s) not be made.
