Claim on behalf of J.D. Helton and J.R. Dowdy, for three hours each at their respective straight time rates, account Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement, particularly the Scope Rule, when it used outside forces to install warning signs with phone numbers and DOT crossing numbers at highway crossing locations on their respective maintenance territories, from February 23 through February 27, 1998. Carrier's File No. 15(98-248, 223, 224, 249, 264). General Chairman's File No.98-57-CD. BRS File Case No. 11006-C&O."

FINDINGS:

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.
