#### STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim on behalf of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the Union Pacific Railroad Company:

Claim on behalf of R. R. Siders, J. W. Braden, B. J. Ward, D. H. Richey, M. J. McNace, J. G. Jensma, and J. J. Lizotte, for payment of 32 hours each at the straight time rate. Account Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement, particularly the Scope Rule, when it allowed outside forces to install 'Automated Horn Systems' and strobe lights to work in conjunction with the Highway Crossing Warning Systems at two locations in Ames, Iowa on April 4 and 5, 2000. This action deprived the Claimants of the opportunity to perform this work. Carrier's File No. 1234313. General Chairman's File No. Nscope-077. BRS File Case No. 11631-UP."

### FINDINGS:

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.
