Hopwood, for one hour at his overtime rate of pay, account Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement, particularly, Rule 13, when it refused to compensate the Claimant for service he was instructed to perform from 16:00 until 17:00 on February 12, 2004. (Carrier's File No. 1396633; General Chairman's File No. N 13 433; BRS File Case No. 13170-UP)."

FINDINGS:
