HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

LONG ISLAND RAILROAD COMPANY

DISPUTE.—"Claim for restoration of position of Ticket Clerk, Rate of Pay \$110.00 per month at Plandome Station, N. Y., and compensation for difference between \$110.00 and \$40.00 per month retroactive to May 21st, 1935."

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that—

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board *ex parte* by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been had and under date of January 20, 1936, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
