PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

DISPUTE.—

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Southern Pacific System (Pacific Lines), that Towerman W. J. Reynolds is entitled to one hour at pro rata under Rule 13 of the Telegraphers' Agreement, for meal period worked by him in French Camp Tower on June 24th, 1934."

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, finds that:
The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been had, and under date of October 19, 1936, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Division advising that:

"A settlement satisfactory to the carrier and our committee has been arrived at and for that reason our committee wishes to withdraw the claim from before your Board."

AWARD

Case dismissed.
