DISPUTE .--

"J. P. McLaughlin that he should have been called to fill temporary vacancy in District Storekeeper's office at South Tacoma September 6th to 9th, inclusive, 1933, and that he be paid for those days, based on Rules 3, 7, and 20 of the Clerks' Schedule."

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that: The dispute was jointly certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board by the parties cited thereto.

No hearing thereon has been had and under date of November 24, 1936, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, stating desire to withdraw their submission to the Adjustment Board.
