DISPUTE.-

"Shall Miss Geraldine Burns and Miss Kathryn McAley be permitted to exercise their seniority on positions of claim checkers, rate \$87.00 per month, Office Auditor of Freight Traffic, Chicago, Ill., and shall they be compensated for monetary loss sustained account not being permitted to so exercise their seniority on such positions on July 3rd, 1933?"

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that: The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been had and under date of April 7, 1937, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing the case.
