THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM.—

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers, Norfolk Southern Railroad, that the proper hourly rate for 'RN' Telegraph Office, Raleigh, N. C., bulletined by the carrier as a new position in March 1934, when the office was moved from one portion of the building in which it is housed to another, is 68¢ an hour and that all employees adversely affected by the company's arbitrary reduction in the rate for this position from 68¢ to 60¢ an hour be compensated at the higher rate retroactively to the date the change in rate was applied."

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that: The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board exparte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been held and, the parties thereto having addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of the case from further consideration by the Board, request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
