"Claim of R. O. Banks, regular assigned messenger and extra check clerk, for wage losses sustained on June 8, 1936, account management failing and refusing to call him to fill a vacancy on position of check clerk, due to the absence of B. Z. Herndon, regular incumbent of that position."
