## STATEMENT OF CLAIM.—

"1. Claim of A. Kemp, Mail Handler, for proper compensation under the rules of the Clerks' current Agreement, for March 7, 1936, and each and every day subsequent thereto that he is not properly compensated under said agreement.

"2. Claim of the Employes that position of Mail Handler comes within the classification of Group 2 of Rule 1 of the Clerks' current Agreement."
