PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers, Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Lines, that Agent-Telegrapher R. R. Roberts was improperly displaced from his regular assigned position as agent at Yountville, Western Division, on November 23, 1932 and that he be restored thereto and compensated in full for any monetary loss sustained."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that:

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been had, and under date of August 14, 1939 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
