FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYEES**

PERE MARQUETTE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood on the Pere Marquette Railway Company, for restoration of position of Car Distributor in the Chief Dispatcher's office, Detroit, Michigan, rate \$235.20 per month and for monetary wage loss sustained by Mr. G. C. Passage, from June 1st, 1938 and all other employees affected thru Carrier's action in the improper abolishment of the position of Car Distributor, as hereinafter outlined."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and the employee involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon was held but not concluded. Under date of September 28, 1939, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
