**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employees on the Chicago, Rock Island and Gulf Railway, under the provisions of Rule 76, in behalf of Mr. A. L. Phillips, cashier, freight office, Dalhart, Texas, rate \$152.20 per month, for pay for period September 11th to September 25th, 1938, a total of twelve (12) working days, while he was away from his position on vacation."

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that:

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That no hearing has been had and under date of December 20, 1939, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw it from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
