STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of Employes' Committee that the restoration to the service on January 9th, 1937, of C. L. Parker, a B&B employe, dismissed, constituted his reinstatement to the service with prior seniority rights unimpaired."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That no hearing thereon has been had, and under date of April 1, 1940, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw it from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
