## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Southern Pacific (Pacific Lines) that the hourly rate of pay of  $86\phi$  for positions of Chief Towerman No. 2 and No. 3, Oakland Pier Tower, Western Division, should not have been reduced to  $83\frac{1}{2}\phi$  per hour when positions No. 6 and No. 7 were abolished and that the schedule rate of  $86\phi$  per hour for these positions be reestablished and that occupants be compensated retroactively from the date the rate was arbitrarily reduced by the Carrier."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party.

That no hearing thereon has been had and under date of June 21, 1940 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
