JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the Joint Council of Dining Car Employes for and in behalf of R. J. Blay for seniority date as Stationary Pantryman from November 25, 1933, and for compensation to the extent suffered retroactive to January 10, 1940, as a result of being unjustly removed from service and denied seniority rights in violattion of the Dining Car Cooks, Waiters-in-Charge, Pantrymen and Waiters Agreement."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party.

That no hearing thereon has been had and under date of October 5, 1940 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
