**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employees, on the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway, under the provisions of Rule 69, in behalf of Ushers located at Englewood Passenger Station, Chicago, Illinois, for adjustment in rates of pay, effective June 3rd, 1940, as follows:
