## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers, Pennsylvania Railroad, that Telegrapher C. S. Fisher is entitled to \$284.19 representing personal expense incurred and the difference between what he earned as telegrapher on the Bloomville-Tiffin relief position, and what he would have earned as telegrapher at 'Q' Office, Toledo, Ohio, between September 1, 1938 and October 1, 1939."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party.

That no hearing thereon has been had, and under date of November 8, 1940 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
