PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

ORDER OF SLEEPING CAR CONDUCTORS THE PULLMAN COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Conductor L. M. Kern, Kansas City District, claims he was removed from his regular assignment in violation of the rules of the Agreement between The Pullman Company and Conductors in the service of The Pullman Company, on August 22, 1940, and asks compensation for all time lost on account of said removal."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party;

That no hearing thereon has been had and under date of December 12, 1940 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
