PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The carrier is violating the Clerk's Agreement at Benavides, Texas by assigning clerical work to employes not covered by the Clerk's Agreement, and in refusing to assign such clerical work to employes holding rights and working under the Clerk's Agreement. Also
- (b) Claim for all losses sustained by employes involved in, or affected by this agreement violation."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party.

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of December 18, 1940, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
