THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(a) The correct rate of pay for the Callers at Laredo, Texas, effective September 15, 1938, is \$104.33 per month. Also

(b) Claim for all losses sustained by employes involved in, or affected by, the carrier's failure and refusal to pay the proper rate of \$104.33 per month."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party.

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of December 20, 1940, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

Case dismissed.
