BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES DELAWARE AND HUDSON RAILROAD

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of Employes' Committee:

"First; that the Carrier violated Schedule Rules 16 (e) and 18 (a) by assigning section laborers, employed at Whitehall, Saratoga Division, to irregular hours on August 14, 15, 25, and 26, 1939 and paying them at pro rata rate for services rendered during irregular and overtime hours.

"Second; that employes listed below shall be paid the difference between what they received at pro rata rate and that which they should have received at time and one-half rate for service rendered as follows:
