## JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the Joint Council of Dining Car Employes for and in behalf of Dining Car Second Cook, Juaraud Jackson and Waiters L. Lodge, F. C. Battey and John Flowers, for continuous time from time required to report until actually released from duty on December 3, 1939 and for these same employes and others similarly situated on subsequent dates since December 3, 1939."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of June 6, 1941, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting that the case be dismissed, which request is hereby granted.
