STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of laid off Section Laborer, Ivan Briggs, Red Oak, Iowa, that he be paid Section Laborer's punitive rate of pay, under the application of Schedule Rule 43 (b) for services performed in connection with the handling of mail at Red Oak, Iowa, on January 13th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 29th, 30th, 31st, February 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 8th, 9th, 17th, 19th, 21st, March 1st, and 2nd, 1940."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That this dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and, under date of July 25, 1941, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
