BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES

**THE DELAWARE AND HUDSON RAILROAD
CORPORATION**

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that Joseph Mesite, Walter R. Adey, Guiseppe Vaglardo, Raffaele Corraro, Angelo Amatuccio, Peter Lavio, Frank Thompson, Sisto Sardello, Silvestro Visedomic, Mike Amatuccio and James Bowen be paid at the rate of time and one-half for eight (8) hours on February 15, 1940, for work performed during an emergency."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held but not concluded. Under date of October 2, 1941, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting that the claim be dismissed, which request is hereby granted.

Case dismissed.
