## JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES ST. LOUIS SOUTHWESTERN RAILWAY LINES

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employes for and in behalf of J. E. Christopher who was formerly employed as a waiter-in-charge by the St. Louis & Southwestern Railway Co., that because of insufficient reason for discharge, he be returned to his former position with full seniority rights unimpaired and compensated for net wage loss."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 11, 1941, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
