## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employes for and in behalf of Hayward Bascom, observation car attendant, in the service of the Northern Pacific Railroad Company, Dining Car Department, that he be paid the net wage loss (270 hours) because of discipline assessed without just cause."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and the employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of December 29, 1941, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw it from further consideration of the Division, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
