BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that, positions now classified as Truck Lift Operators and compensated at rate of 62¢ per hour in Stores Department of the Carrier at Sacramento, California, be reclassified as Car Loader Operators and given rate of 67½¢ per hour, retroactive to April 16, 1940."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That this dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of January 7, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
