PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

UNITED TRANSPORT SERVICE EMPLOYES OF AMERICA SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim for additional compensation for red cap porters L. T. Brown and C. J. LaSelve, employes at Fresno, California, San Joaquin Division.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and the employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of March 25, 1942, the employes and the carrier jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw it from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
