STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brother-hood that W. R. Smith, Clerk, Proctor Minnesota Yard Office, be compensated properly at the established rate of the position or \$205.00 per month, retroactive to April 9, 1941, on which date he was assigned to the position as relief clerk and ore sorter, including all time worked until Sept. 1, 1941, on which date the proper and established rate was applied to the position.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that:

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been held, and under date of April 15, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
