- 1. That Chris Mec'leris be reinstated to his former position as Section Foreman with full seniority rights.
- 2. That he be paid for all time lost from the date of his dismissal to the date he was returned to service as Section Laborer; and
- 3. That he be paid the difference between what he earned as Section Laborer and what he would have earned as Section Foreman.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under dates of May 26, 1942 and June 1, 1942, the parties addressed formal communications to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
