PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES

PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council, Dining Car Employees, Local 370, of the Hotel & Restaurant Employees International Alliance on the property of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, for and in behalf of Thomas Daniel and other employees similarly situated that—

1. Thomas Daniel and others be compensated for work performed as Dining Car Stewards on June 25th, 1941, and for subsequent service since that date.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of June 25, 1942, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
