STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Lines, that Agent-Telegrapher H. A. Stiver, Los Gatos, Coast Division, be compensated for overtime worked under Rule 14 of the Telegraphers' Agreement, on the following dates:

October 25, 1939, 1 hour, 50 minutes; October 26, 1939, 2 hours, 5 minutes; October 27, 1939, 1 hour, 5 minutes; October 28, 1939, 1 hour, 5 minutes.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of July 22, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
