PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE ERIE RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes, that the Carrier violated the rules of the Clerks' Agreement dated September 1, 1936 when it requires the occupant of position designated as Distribution Clerk No. 2 to perform higher rated duties at a lower rate of pay in violation of Rule 36 of the Clerks' Agreement, and

That the Carrier shall now be required to establish a rate of pay commensurate with the duties performed which shall be not less than \$180.20 per month.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held but not concluded. Under date of August 25, 1942, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
