PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- 1. That preparation of tonnage report is assignable to employes in seniority section 21.
- 2. That position preparing tonnage report be bulletined in, and assigned to an employe of seniority section 21.
- 3. That successful bidder be retroactively compensated to August 1, 1940, for any monetary loss sustained by reason of the Carrier's failure to assign this position to seniority section 21.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 1, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
