BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD SIGNALMEN OF AMERICA

INTERNATIONAL-GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: (a) That F. R. Jones be paid the difference in the assistant signalman's rate of pay and the rate of pay of a signalman for all services performed covering the period June 7, 1940 to April 23, 1941.

(b) That F. R. Jones' seniority date as a signalman shall be January 11, 1940.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Boards finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 27, 1942, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting the withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
