**THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS**  
**THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA & SANTA FE RAILWAY**  
**COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers, Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, that an hourly rate of 76¢ shall be applied to the telegrapher-cashier position at Fairview, Oklahoma, effective November 1, 1940, the date said position was changed from telegrapher-clerk to telegrapher-cashier classification.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 3, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
