**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the Delivery Clerk at Houston, Texas be paid one hour's overtime at the rate of time and one-half for each day his meal period was assigned in violation of the Agreements.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 30, 1942 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.
