PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Lines, that Telegrapher J. B. Neff be compensated under the provisions of Rule 4 (b) of the Telegraphers' Agreement for relief service performed by him at various points, July 24, 1939 to October 24, 1939, inclusive.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of September 8, 1942 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

Case dismissed.
